Chestnut Filly, (Mar), by Curlin - Magical Flash by Miswaki. Trainer Schettino Dominick. Bred by Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings LLC(KY).

FLASH FORWARD came away in good order, went four then three wide early on the first turn, was tucked into the two path midway through that bend, settled nicely in the middle of the field, ranged up under light coaxing while three wide on the far turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths, floated out to the four path while making a bid at the top of the stretch, disposed of TOASTING while under a right-handed whip into the final furlong, continued under a right-handed whip while quickly drawing away then was put to a strong hand ride in the final seventy yards while much the best. TOASTING charged the front of the gate prior to the start, struck the front of the stall with the side of her face, came away well, raced off the rail on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid midway through the far turn, turned into the stretch under a drive, drifted out alongside FLASH FORWARD shortly thereafter, lost touch with that rival into the final furlong, drifted out again at that point and proved no match while able to get the place. PROFETIZA was asked from the start, went three then two wide early on the first turn, dropped close to the rail late on that bend, set the pace through moderate fractions, was asked while inside on the far turn, dropped out under a drive into upper stretch and tired while just able to get the show. SISTER STATE was taken in hand nearing the first turn then rated on the inside, raced just behind the pacesetter while under some restraint on the backstretch, came under urging while inching a bit off the inside on the far turn, was put to the whip outside the quarter-pole, dropped back under a drive and weakened. GRAND MERE settled on the inside, was coaxed along midway down the backstretch, shifted off the rail early on the far turn while ridden along, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SKYFALL was last away, raced off the inside on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along by the half-mile pole, came under stronger urging while off the rail on the far turn and failed to respond.
