furlong out. NORTHERN PASSION settled well off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. QUEEN'S DAUGHTER (FR) broke in the air, settled off the pace, angled out late turn then finished evenly inside. SISTERLY LOVE showed brief speed then stalked

the duel from the rail, was steadied late turn and again upper stretch and lacked a rally.
