LLANARMON settled off the pace, closed along the rail on the turn, angled out approaching the stretch, rallied, veered out to avoid the fallen rider a furlong out, bid a 16th out and prevailed driving. SPANISH FLOWER stalked the pace three-wide, chased into the stretch, was steadied slightly a furlong out then finished gamely. APPRECIATING settled off the pace, quickened three-wide late turn and finished under a determined drive. MADLY TRULY settled off the pace, swung wide at the top of the stretch and rallied outside. SKYLANDER GIRL hit the gate leaving, stalked the pace from between horses, chased into the stretch and finished all out. UNSPURNED, clear early, set a pressured pace on the turn, was headed 3/16th out then jumped the fallen rider with a furlong to run, raced gamely to deep stretch and tired. SPRING LIKEACOBRA showed brief speed then stalked the pace, dropped back late on the backstretch, chased four-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. READY TO ACT, off a step slowly, stalked the pace, chased into the stretch, bid 3/16th out and took a clear lead, veered in sharply when roused from the right side a furlong out and unseated her rider. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE ACCIDENT IN THE STRETCH LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED. The filly walked off the track.
