Dark Bay or Brown Horse, (May), by Street Sense - Pilfer by Deputy Minister. Trainer McLaughlin P. Kiaran. Bred by Siena Farms LLC (KY).

ELNAAWI settled in the clear and well within striking distance, edged up three wide mid way on the final turn, angled six wide approaching the lane, surged to command heading towards the furlong grounds and eagerly pulled away when put to an emphatic left handed drive. TURCO BRAVO (CHI), unhurried early, gained off the rail leaving the three eighths pole, angled five wide for the drive and rallied between rivals to nab the place in the final yards. COSMIC GOLD, in close attendance five wide under snug rating, drew on near even terms between rivals in upper stretch, failed to seriously go on when let out and faded in the final seventy yards. WEALTH TO ME broke a step slow then was brushed, was taken well wide past the three quarter pole, commenced a bit of a run five wide under pressure past the five sixteenths, shifted out wider in the lane and had belated action. STORMIN MONARCHO, four wide between rivals prompting the pace, was under a ride chasing past the five sixteenths, altered in for the stretch run, held well to mid stretch then faded. CERRO (IRE) took outside pressure around the first turn and into the backstretch, edged away a bit under rating past the five eighths, drifted out holding command into the lane, kept on to mid stretch then gradually gave way. A. P. CINO, off the pace, came four wide for the drive and lacked a solid kick. RIVER RUSH stalked the pace under rating while saving ground, crept closer after six furlongs, angled out in upper stretch, chased to mid stretch then gave way. GOING TO MARKET stalked the pace three wide, was under pressure past the five sixteenths and weakened. FRED HIGH, off the pace while saving some ground, swung wide in upper stretch but failed to menace.
