MAST TRACK was sent to the early lead and set a pressured pace inside, inched away into the second turn, kicked clear leaving that turn and held on gamely under some urging and strong handling while drifting out a bit late. HIGH COURT DRAMA (IRE) chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch, was four wide a sixteenth out and edged a foe for the place. NEKO BAY between horses early, angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out in the stretch, split horses past midstretch and just missed second. TRES BORRACHOS four wide early, angled in and prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked that one just off the rail on the second turn, was outside a foe in midstretch and between horses in deep stretch and weakened. SQUARE EDDIE pulled under a hold to stalk the pace just off the rail, angled to the inside into the stretch and lacked the needed response in the final furlong.
