GRAYDAR went four wide on the first turn, relaxed while tracking the pace on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, made a bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive at that point, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, battled alongside

MARK VALESKI into the final furlong, grabbed the lead from that rival passing the sixteenth-pole then moved clear late under continued right hand urging. MARK VALESKI bumped with MACHO MACHO at the start, showed early speed, went three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, gained the lead outside the five-sixteenths pole, was asked passing that marker, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, held a short lead into the final furlong, lost the advantage entering the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get the place. BOURBON COURAGE settled while off the inside, was ridden along on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, raced alongside of MACHO MACHO, brushed with that rival inside the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the show. MACHO MACHO bumped with MARK VALESKI at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was asked near the half-mile pole, raced three wide while urged along on the far turn, came under the whip while outside of BOURBON COURAGE in upper stretch, brushed with that rival inside the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick and missed the show. FLAT OUT was reserved while inside on the first turn, moved off the rail on the backstretch, was roused while two then three wide on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, was switched to a left-handed whip at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response while under continued left hand urging. MAJESTIC HARBOR went to the front, raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, vied inside early on the far turn, lost the lead outside the five-sixteenths pole, dropped out outside the quarter-pole and gave way.
