By subscription of \$400 by Saturday, March 15. \$2,000 to pass the entry box, \$2,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations will be accepted by 12:00 noon on Thursday March 20 at a fee of \$12,000 which shall include entry and starting fees. \$400,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weights: Thursday March 20. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The New Orleans Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 15, 2014, with 18 nominations. PALACE MALICE went four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, advanced three wide leaving the backstretch, pounced on the leader midway through the far turn while moving to the four path, floated five wide late on that bend, came six wide into the stretch, edged clear a drive, was put to a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker, continued under the whip until outside the sixteenth-pole then proved much the best under a brisk hand ride. NORMANDY INVASION raced in the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide early on the far turn, advanced in the five path at the five-sixteenths, came seven wide into the stretch, chased the winner under a drive and proved no match while well clear for the place. SUNBEAN was well placed on the inside, waited behind rivals on the far turn, lost position near the five-sixteenths, shifted three wide at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. FORDUBAI went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased two to three wide on the far turn and faded. GOLDEN SOUL went three wide early on the first turn then dropped close to the rail, settled at the rear while under some urging, was ridden along while two to three wide on the far turn and faltered. BRADESTER went to the front, raced in the two path on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, lost the lead just inside the three-eighths pole and stopped.
