UNBRIDLED HUMOR left alertly and pressed the issue from the two path, with the rider atop with a firm grip on the reins, moved when ready, powering her way past SPRING PARTY to take charge before reaching the turn, drew out to a lengthy advantage making her way to the quarter pole, emerged from the furlong grounds, having surrendered none of it, and finished the race under a mild, but very confident hand ride. THAI HAKU (IRE) saved ground, angled out in the stretch, finished with good energy to be second best. AQUITAINE unhurried during the initial stages, was already encouragement spinning from the five path into upper stretch, continued on willingly to secure the show. AVIATE (GB) left the rail midway down the backstretch, altered course coming to the eighth pole, and rallied mildly. SEA ROAD underwent a three wide journey and folded. SPRING PARTY chased from the outside and was through after going six furlongs. TWILIGHT MEMORY was lightly urged to the front, vied for the lead from the inside, got displaced before reaching the half mile pole and faltered.
