**Bay Filly, (Apr), by War Front - Preserver by Forty Niner. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Cherry Valley Farm, LLC(KY).**

PEACE PRESERVER along the inside route on the opening bend, wandered into the two path down the backstretch before re tucking along the rail on the far turn, contently saved ground, remained under a firm hold nearing the quarter pole, tipped into the two path at the top of the lane and was asked for run, closed in to become part of cluster consisting of every horse by the end of the run through the furlong grounds, hesitated for a stride before split rivals leaving the sixteenth pole, kicked in with good energy once safely through the opening to grab a narrow advantage then dug in with good determination to preserve it. HUNGRY ISLAND under a firm hold while stalking the pacesetter from the outside, responded positively when given her cue spinning into the lane, closed in well to procure the place. BETTER LUCKY raced from off the rail throughout, chose the three path as the one to take departing the backstretch, got asked for a response prior to reaching the quarter pole, eventually fanned to be five wide, got straightened away and took off in earnest after the front runners, while rallying with interest when bumped by the errant former leader in the final stages. ASSATEAGUE away in good order, quickly established control, rated kindly while showing the way from the inside, for what was for the most part a loosely-contested lead, drifted into the two path by the head of the stretch, continued to drift out towards the middle of the course racing through the furlong grounds while desperately clinging to the barest of leads and while being heavily pressed by others from all sides, yielded in the last eighth then made contact with BETTER LUCKY in deep stretch. NAPLES BAY stumbled at the start, patiently tracked the leader from the pocket, turned for home with clear sailing available along the rail, launched a rally to loom a bold threat with a furlong remaining, flattened out. LAUGH OUT LOUD (GB) well rated in the two path for the opening three-quarters, gave way.
