WIGMORE HALL (IRE) raced in midpack well in hand, was set down along the rail at the top of the stretch, rallied quickly, bid a furlong out, gained the lead then held under a drive. SIMMARD raced off the pace, closed outside rivals late backstretch, bid into the turn, quickly moved clear, set the pace, was caught a furlong out and well headed but battled back gamely and just missed. AL KHALI raced off the pace, was steadied at the rear along the rail entering the far turn, angled out a bit late turn and again upper stretch, launched a determined charge and closed steadily. LAUREATE CONDUCTOR raced in midpack, was roused four-wide at the top of the stretch then finished gamely in vain. HAILSTONE, in range, came two and three-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the final furlong. HOTEPE stalked the pace early, settled in midpack on the turn, was under a determined drive in the stretch but evened out in the late stages. SEASIDE RETREAT stalked the pace in hand, chased four-wide into the stretch then evened out in the final furlong. BOURBON BAY led the way in hand, was engaged at the far turn, was quickly headed, chased to the stretch and tired in the late stages.
