JOHN SCOTT angled in and settled outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and finished with interest. DAVE IN DIXIE unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came out a bit in the stretch and also finished well between foes late. ALFARABI close up stalking the pace off the rail, came out into the stretch and weakened. CAME ABOARD chased between horses then outside a rival, split horses on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn, came out

some in the stretch and lacked the needed response. SEATTLE RULER angled in and settled a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. LUCKY RAVE (GB) pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, remained along the rail on the second turn and weakened. STERLING OUTLOOK bobbled at the start, sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the stretch.
