CENTRING rated along the rail for the opening three-quarters, was given her cue and angled sharply four wide into the stretch, settled into her best stride nearing the furlong marker, charged at the first two finishers with good, but belated energy en route for the show. DISPOSABLEPLEASURE chased three wide, failed to respond when roused at the three-eighths pole and tired. JOYFUL VICTORY put to some light hand urging, edged away to a narrow advantage, cut the
