1 1/4 MILES. (1.472) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 OHIO DERBY (GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$150 by Tuesday September 22, 2009, Or all horses which have started in Graded Stakes at any Magna Tracks in 2009 shall nominate for \$75. Supplementary nominations accepted to the Ohio Derby of \$3,000 due by Tuesday September 22, 2009, \$750 to enter and \$750 additional to start with \$150,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 3% to fifth; and 2% to sixth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-Winners of \$90,000 twice at a mile or over in 2009 allowed 3 lbs; of \$90,000 at a mile or over in 2009; 5 lbs; of \$90,000 at any distance 7 lbs; of \$50,000 at any distance 9 lbs (MCOS not considered in weight allowances). The Ohio Derby will be limited to fourteen (14) Starters, in the event not more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box by 10:30 A.M. Eastern Standard Time, Tuesday September 29, 2009, preference will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest lifetime earnings at the time of closing entries. Lifetime earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. A Trophy to the winning Owner, Trainer & Jockey. (Cloudy 60)

GONE ASTRAY stalked the pace and saved ground, rallied at the quarter pole and angled out, closed stoutly and drew clear late under strong handling. WAR FIGHTER was away alertly and set the pace through moderate fractions while nicely rated on the front end, could not match strides with the winner late but was clearly second best. ICE ROAD contended throughout, was no match for the top two through the lane but was best of the rest. JOIN IN THE DANCE rank early while between horses, steadied into the first turn, saved ground but failed to mount a late bid. PERFECT START had good early position, weakened on the second turn. FONDA RONDA WON never far back early, raced four wide down the backside and had no late kick. PETCH pressed the pace from the inside, stopped badly in the stretch.
