MENSA HEAT chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out into the stretch, gained the lead past midstretch and inched clear under urging. LEGAL SEPARATION stalked off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch, took the advantage in upper stretch, inched away briefly in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. SPUD SPIVENS saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and just got the show. SCOFIELD BARRACKS settled a bit off the rail then inside, chased just off the fence on the turn, came out in the stretch and just missed third. CHILOQUIN sent along outside then angled in and dueled outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MARK THE BENCH had good early speed off the fence then angled in, dueled inside, inched away briefly leaving the turn, fought back into the stretch but also weakened in the final furlong. RED DEFENSE chased just off the inside then along the rail into and on the turn, came off the fence in the drive and also weakened.
