MOLLYS MISSB'HAVIN set a pressured pace from the start then dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then was brushed twice by **TAPATIA** in the stretch and proved best over that rival in the end. **TAPATIA** was pressing the pace while two wide, moved up and dueled for the lead from the outside, lugged in in the stretch and brushed the winner twice then hung. **MOON LARRY** was well placed while racing on the inside, saved ground on the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but came up empty in late stretch. **LOST MY HALO** was five wide on the first turn then made a bid three wide into the far turn but flattened out in the drive. **HATTER NU NU** was two wide on the backstretch and chasing the pace, was used up and faltered in the stretch. **HEAVENS HALL** was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn then was no factor. **MISTY'S SHADOW** was three wide on the far turn then was no factor.
