GAME ON DUDE had good early speed and angled in, set the pace along the inside, kicked clear on the second turn and drew off in the stretch under urging. **KETTLE CORN** settled off the rail then outside on the backstretch, went between foes on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, came out in the drive and got up for second between horses late. **YOU KNOW I KNOW** saved ground off the pace, was in a bit tight off heels into the second turn, came out into the stretch, went between horses in midstretch then split rivals late for the show. **RICHARD'S KID** unhurried and angled in off the rail early, came out nearing the second turn, swung five wide into the stretch and finished with interest but was edged for the show. **HOLDING GLORY (BRZ)** broke a bit slowly and awkwardly, pulled some and saved ground chasing the pace, waited off heels leaving the second turn, split rivals past midstretch and was edged for a minor award. **DELEGATION** had speed well out in the strip early then angled in and stalked off the rail to the stretch, was no match for the winner in the drive and weakened some late. **BYRAMA (GB)** chased outside a rival, moved up three deep leaving the backstretch, continued between horses leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. **DULLAHAN** unhurried and angled in between horses early, went outside a rival on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. **JERANIMO** chased three deep then went up five wide leaving the backstretch, continued three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed rally in the drive. **ENDORSEMENT** saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and weakened. **FARRAAJ (IRE)** pulled his way along outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the first turn, went up four wide leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, continued four wide into the stretch and also weakened. **BLUESKIESRAINBOWS** kept wide in the run to the wire the first time, angled in at the first sixteenth pole, stalked outside a rival then between horses, dropped back between foes on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
