JOES BLAZING AARON set a comfortable pace, responded when asked and drew off under urging. QUEEN'SPLATEKITTEN had a three wide trip, finished well outside and dug in gamely to earn the place. NEWSDAD raced off the pace, advanced inside on the far turn, angled out, split rivals and finished willingly. EAST OF DANZIG had a ground saving trip and rallied mildly on the rail. ARI C tracked inside, chased two wide on the far turn and weakened. MASTER DUNKER stalked the pace, raced between rivals and tired. LIBERTY CAP raced off the rail and failed to respond. RAFAE was outrun early, swung five wide entering the stretch and failed to threaten. ARTFUL RUN was off a bit slow, saved ground, then raced between rivals, was steadied and shuffled back entering the far turn and tired.
