CARRIBEAN SUNSET (IRE) wide in

the chute, angled in and chased outside a rival then between foes on the backstretch and into the second turn, continued toward the inside into the stretch, came out a bit in upper stretch and again for room in deep stretch and went willingly to the wire. WILD PROMISES stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the backstretch, tracked that one again on the second turn and outside the winner into the stretch, came out some in the drive and was outfinished. MEYDAN PRINCESS (IRE) chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DAWN AFTER DAWN stalked outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, continued outside on that turn and weakened in the stretch. BEL AIR SIZZLE angled in and settled off the pace inside, saved ground throughout to no avail. MISSIT (IRE) stalked outside a rival then three deep, dropped back off the rail on the second turn and weakened.
