EUROEARS sent along inside, dueled early then inched away on the backstretch, set all the pace inside and won clear under left handed urging. CAPTAIN CHEROKEE had speed outside the winner then stalked between horses on the backstretch and alongside a rival leaving the turn and was second best. SMILING TIGER sent inside early, stalked along the rail throughout, could make no impact in the stretch and just held third. VENTANA chased a bit off the rail, angled to the inside into the stretch, came out some in the drive and just missed third outside SMILING TIGER on the line. HUNCH settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out in upper stretch, lugged in off heels in midstretch and lacked a rally. GATO GO WIN stalked outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, continued off the inside leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch.
