1 1/2 MILES. (Turf) (2.223) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 PAN AMERICAN S. (GRADE II) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. (\$15,000 bonus for FTBOA Registered Florida-Bred by an FTBOA Registered Florida Sire). Free nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start, with \$200,000 Guaranteed. The owner of the winner to receive \$120,000, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth, \$6,000 to fifth and \$4,000 to sixth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes over nine furlongs on the turf since October 1, allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes over nine furlongs since September 1, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 over nine furlongs since September 1, 6 lbs. In the event this stakes is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Supplemental Nominations at time of entry with a fee of \$7,500. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 15, 2014 with 45 Nominations and 1 Supplemental Nomination. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Quarter) (Rail at 96 feet) (Cloudy 79)

Dark Bay or Brown Horse, (Apr), by Arch - Storm Tracer by Pulpit. Trainer Mott I. William. Bred by James S. Karp(KY). NEWSDAD outrun early, began advancing three wide around the final turn, then rallied along the outside to take over late while just holding off VERTIFORMER. The latter, reserved off the pace while racing along the rail into the stretch the final time, responded to pressure in the drive and rallied to just miss. SLUMBER (GB) unhurried early, advanced three wide down the backstretch and around the final turn to reach contention, rallied to reach even terms for command in deep stretch but was outfinished. JOES BLAZING AARON set the pace along the rail to deep stretch and gave way. CHARMING KITTEN tracked the pace, advanced on the backstretch to chase the leaders around the far turn and into the stretch but had no response in the drive. JOHA stalked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch the final time, then tired. ADMIRAL KITTEN failed to menace. SUNTRACER was not a factor. OCEAN SEVEN (IRE) was through after a mile. RUSSIAN GREEK stalked the pace, made a run at the leader racing into the far turn, then faded.
