Chestnut Filly, (Feb), by Syncline - Wolanstonita (CHI) by Wagon Master (FR). Trainer Sheppard E. Jonathan. Bred by George Strawbridge (PA).

SUGAR AGAIN settled nicely on the outside, kept a watchful eye on DELUXE late on the backstretch, inched clear on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, was put to a strong hand drive, rallied outside under a right-handed whip, closed strongly to get the lead entering the final sixteenth then just held off the fast closing runner-up. DELUXE brushed with a rival at the start, was taken in hand early, went three wide on the first turn, tucked into the two path entering the backstretch, was reserved well off the pace, came under urging while off the inside on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, was put to a drive, came under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker and closed fast to just miss. THUNDERING EMILIA brushed with a rival at the start, was taken in hand while just off the heels of the leader entering the first turn, tracked that rival on the outside down the backstretch, chased on the far turn, battled determinedly under a drive in the stretch, made a bid between rivals entering the final sixteenth but was outfinished late while able to get the show. EVADING TEMPETE (GB) went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, battled willingly while under a drive in the stretch, made a bid between rivals entering the final sixteenth but was also outfinished then missed the show. SEA ROAD stumbled at the start but broke with the field, was reserved while off the inside, came under urging on the far turn, swung six wide at the top of the stretch and finished willingly near the center of the course. UNBRIDLED ESSENCE settled towards the rear while on the inside, was roused while continuing to save ground on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and also finished willingly. ULTIMATE CLASS set the pace through moderate fractions, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under the whip near the furlong marker, lost the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and weakened late. HIT IT RICH was well placed just off the pace while on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, chased along the hedge in upper stretch, lacked sufficient room on the inside in the final furlong and lost whatever chance she had. BET ON THE BLUE settled on the inside, dropped back while urged along on the far turn, came off the inside in upper stretch and failed to rally. IT'S TEA TIME went three wide early on the initial turn then tucked into the two path, lingered at the back of the field while on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, moved to five wide at the top of the stretch, came in shortly thereafter and failed to threaten.
