 PAYNTER had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, inched away and came off the rail into the stretch and won clear under a steady hand ride and a long hold late. MAJESTIC CITY sent between horses early, prompted the pace outside the winner until nearing the stretch, could not match that one in the drive but was clearly second best. FLY LEXIS FLY broke out a bit, went up four wide to chased the pace, went three deep into the turn, continued off the rail on the bend and into the stretch and just held third. KATE'S EVENT chased off the rail then three deep between horses on the backstretch, angled in outside a rival on the turn, went three wide leaving the turn and into the stretch and just missed the show. GRAND BERRY (ARG) between rivals early, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, split horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. DIME QUE (CHI) angled in and stalked the pace inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and weakened. ASHTAR (CHI) unhurried along the inside on the backstretch and into the turn, came a bit off the rail on the turn and failed to menace. CHARLIE'SBOYWINS chased off the rail then between horses, dropped back a bit off the fence on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and was done early.
