TAKEOVER TARGET sat forwardly placed three wide on both turns, got set down challenging in earnest heading into the stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds as the new leader, dug in with good determination only to reluctantly release the lead right near the wire. STARTUP NATION underwent a three wide journey to the quarter pole, waited momentarily approaching that station before angling outward, wound up the six path with a furlong to go, rallied with belated energy to grab the show award. WORLD APPROVAL stalked the pace from the two path, kept up the pursuit to midstretch before weakening. MADE IN DETROIT made light contact with the winner almost immediately after springing from the gate, was under a firm hold powering its way to the front, cut over to the rail, rated kindly setting the splits, with WORLD APPROVAL in close attendance from the two path, came under intensified pressure after going six furlongs, succumbed traversing through the furlong grounds and backed away. EH CUMPARI tucked along the rail shortly after the start, advanced towards the pacesetter racing along the backstretch, was taken out in upper stretch, lacked the necessary stretch offering.
