The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers if there were six (6) or more starters. All starters will be guaranteed no less than \$1,000. If only five (5) were to start the purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. Three Year Olds, 116 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 twice since August 31, 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2011, 4 lbs.; a Grade 2 in 2011, 6 lbs. ASK THE MOON away in good order, broke near the top, gradually worked her way towards the inside, tucking near the rail just after entering the first turn, was well rated on a loose lead, entrenched slightly off the rail, sailed along down the backstretch and around the far turn, felt the presence of others for the initial time upon reaching upper stretch and got called upon, drifted outward several paths at the three-sixteenths pole and then again at the eighth pole, while still maintaining a clear advantage, left that station on a truer course and edged away. PACHATTACK placed under a good hold leaving the starting gate, took up a forward spot, lost position as ACRONYM eased off the inside just after departing the homestretch, remained three wide accompanying the leader until nearing the end of the backstretch, was asked for some run and resumed the chase two wide on the far turn, failed to gain ground appreciably the entire way around, was set down and closed the gap slightly on the errant front runner during the next eighth, began to lose contact once again when that opponent went back on a straight course then just held off TIZ MIZ SUE to salvage second. TIZ MIZ SUE judiciously took the inside route on the first turn, swung into the two path entering the backstretch, bided time under a good hold proceeding her way towards the half mile pole, began to pick up the pace, was placed three wide at the three-eighths pole, spun from there into the lane, was put to a drive once settled into upper stretch, got outfinished. PROTESTING was reserved saving ground, vacated the rail leaving the half mile pole, was in two path just long enough to steer past a tiring rival, ducked back to the rail once sufficiently clear, cut the corner under encouragement, lacked the necessary stretch response. SUPER ESPRESSO darted over to the inside soon after the start, rode the rail on the opening bend before placed outside entering the backstretch, sat reserved in midpack, attempted to follow TIZ MIZ SUE on the second turn, loosely drafted behind that opponent into the stretch, had no kick. ACRONYM was grabbed hold during the straightaway approach leading up to the first turn, conceded the lead to the top one and had no sooner done so when she squeezed her way into the two path, attended the pace from the outside until the half mile pole, was taken to the rail at that point, steadily tired thereafter.
