A supplemental nomination fee of \$500 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the close of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees to receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally among the remaining finishers. 120 lbs.; Non-winners of a race on the turf other than claiming a allowed 2 lbs.; Maiden, 4 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The NYRA reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. Closed Wednesday, August 21, 2013 with 19 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, Two-Year-Old races will be run at Seven Furlongs and races for Three-Year-Olds and Up will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.). Bay Filly, (Apr), by Kitten's Joy - Granny Franny by Grand Slam. Trainer Brown C. Chad. Bred by Kenneth L. Ramsey & Sarah K. Ramsey(KY).

GRANNY MC'S KITTEN was rated on the inside while into the bit, leveled out near the five-eighths pole, was well placed just behind the leader, drafted behind that rival on the far turn, waited patiently turning into the stretch, was asked after finding a seam between foes near the three-sixteenths, rallied to the lead under a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, was carried out in the process then moved clear under strong handling. DUFF ONE broke a step slow, was rank off heels at the rear of the field entering the first turn, raced off the hedge on that bend, settled more kindly on the backstretch, came under increasing urging while two to three wide on the far turn, drifted out under a left-handed whip after turning into the stretch, was switched to a right-handed whip and straightened by the rider, gained her best stride in the final furlong and finished with good courage to garner the place. MISS FROST bounded to the front, raced off the hedge on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, vied a bit off the hedge on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, drifted out under a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, lost the lead to the winner and weakened while able to get the show. CHASE MY TAIL was taken in hand while a bit eager into the first turn, saved ground on that bend, was reserved at the back, raced inside on the far turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, moved out some under a drive in upper stretch and failed to rally. CANDY KITTY went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn, was given her cue near the quarter-pole, chased under a whip in upper stretch and gave way. LA REINE BOURBON went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced four wide on the far turn, came under urging near the five-sixteenths, was carried out just after turning into the stretch, drifted closer to the inside and failed to respond.
