IMPERÍA vacated the inside route after entering the full turn, angled into the four path during the next furlong, swung one path wider into the stretch, blew by the runner up in the final seventy yards. VISION PERFECT broke alertly and maintained the advantage, set the splits from

the inside, with FACE THE NATION in close attendance parked off his hind quarters, rider aboard with a relaxed hold initially, got set down for the drive home, drifted into the two path almost immediately afterwards, held out with good determination before releasing the lead with under

a sixteenth remaining. OFFERING PLAN hung out three wide on the chute, swung from the four path into the stretch, finished willingly to grab the show award. STARTUP NATION at or near the inside proceeding towards the half mile pole, raced around the turn in the two path under

encouragement, displayed some late foot en route to earning the last major check. FACE THE MUSIC prompted the runner up from the two path to the guarter pole, failed to fire when called upon entering the stretch. STRONG COFFEE raced three wide heading for the backstretch, was briefly strung out on the inner border of the overland route past the three-eighths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. ALL I KARABOUT underwent a three wide journey, folded. NUTTY FUTTY between foes to the half mile pole, was guided over to the hedge at that station, had no offering to give after cutting the corner into the lane. ARTIE'S FLIGHT raced along the outside and was outrun.
