1 1/4 MILES. (Turf) (1.40) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *PIN OAK STUD USA S.* (PLUS UP TO \$13,500 Open ATB) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$1,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,250 to start with \$150,000 guaranteed of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$16,500 to third, \$9,000 to fourth and \$4,500 to fifth. Weights: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2006, 5 lbs.; \$30,000 anytime, 7 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, May 17, 2006 with 26 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth.).

STREAM CAT bumped with a rival after the start, was well placed on the inside, waited patiently early on the final turn, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, rallied four wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker then inched clear under steady handling. WAIT IN LINE leaned out at the start, pressed the pace on the inside while under a hold, moved to the lead midway down the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, held a short lead into the final furlong, was collared outside the sixteenth-pole then outfinished. AVER came in after the start and had DESERT WHEAT clip his heels, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, vied into the final furlong then weakened while able to secure the show. MORE THAN REGAL bumped with a rival after the start then was in tight, was reserved on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally. MINSTREL RUNNER set the early pace while off the rail, relinquished the lead midway down the backstretch, vied between rivals on the far turn, battled into the final furlong then gave way. DESERT WHEAT was unprepared at the start then shut-off and clipped heels, lagged at the rear of the field, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and came up empty. After the race, the rider of DESERT WHEAT claimed foul against the rider of AVER. Following the stewards' review, AVER was disqualified from third and placed sixth for interference after the start. (Rail at 0 Feet)
