KING KREESA away well, crossed to be on the pace just off the inside lightly coaxed, marshaled the field down the backside into the far turn, remained patiently handled swinging just off the inside into the stretch, got roused nearing the eighth pole, dug in holding sway under a drive to prevail. HOWE GREAT settled into a pocket trip early on down the backside while in hand, shifted to the three path out of the pocket at the half mile pole, remained on hold until set down three wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild kick drifting slightly a furlong out under near sided encouragement but was repulsed to the line while safe for the place. BIG SCREEN three wide within range of the front, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, continued three wide for home, dug in with a mild kick to hold for the show honors. DATA LINK four wide in mid pack in the clear down the backside, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths continuing four wide through to the quarter pole when roused, angled inside nearing the eighth pole as HOWE GREAT drifted slightly in front, offered up mild kick but was outfinished to the wire. LUBASH fought the bit early on under stout restraint and was wrangled back to be placed behind cover three wide towards the rear, remained on hold until the five-sixteenths when let out, angled five wide in upper stretch, rallied into contention along the outside in the final furlong but was out kicked by the top foursome. SHKSPEARE SHALIYAH off half a beat slow at the break, saved ground at the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide for home and made no impact. UPGRADE steadied early on leaving the dog legged chute into the backside along the fence as BIG SCREEN crossed in front to the inside, saved ground in mid pack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and weakened in the stretch.
