1 MILE. (Turf) (1.313) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 POKER S. (GRADE III) FOR FOUR- YEAR- OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$6,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weights, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$120,000 twice at a mile or over in 2013- 2014 allowed 2 lbs.; such a race in 2013-14 allowed 4 lbs.; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2013-14 allowed 6 lbs.; two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2014 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, May 10, 2014 with 34 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.) (Rail at 27 feet). (Clear 84)

JACK MILTON contently rode the rail to the five-sixteenths marker, got fanned into the five path heading for the three-sixteenths pole, responded positively when given his cue, gained a narrow lead with about a furlong to go and kicked away, kept to encouragement. BIG SCREEN bobbed after breaking awkwardly, kept watch on the pacesetter while taking the inside route, picked up interest when asked a few jumps prior to the quarter pole, turned for home just behind a wall composed of four rivals, slipped into the two path shortly afterwards, split opponents with a furlong remaining while rallying, came home willingly but had to settle for the place. ZA APPROVAL off the inside, issued a challenge three wide heading for home, flattened out. PLAINVIEW raced three wide on the chute, stalked from afar while proceeding down the backstretch, closed the gap readily upon departing it, was between rivals entering the stretch, remained a prominent factor for an additional furlong before backing away. SINATRA was hung out in three path travelling along the chute, continued from off the inside thereafter, but slightly closer to the rail for the next half, swung four wide into the stretch having been put to some urging, lacked the needed response. PEACE AND JUSTICE along the rail, sped off, rider atop with a firm grip on the reins, came under assault as the third fraction was being recorded, succumbed in short order and faltered.
