FURY KAPCORI quickly established control while coming in slightly around the initial turn, dictated the pace to second turn, padded cushion early on that bend, remained slightly off the rail and powered away in final eighth under right hand urging. HANDSOME MIKE was taken off the rail early and pulled himself to stalking position outside pacesetter into backstretch, continued prominently while bit off the fence, lost contact in upper stretch but safely held second. MAJESTIC CITY was bit antsy in the gate, angled over and tracked pace from the inside, moved up some on the backstretch, dropped back bit around last turn, angled out in upper stretch and bested others. AMERICAN BLEND checked off heels into the first turn, settled off the pace and off the rail, chased two wide into the stretch and lacked needed response from the inside. SECRETSATMIDNIGHT unhurried from along the rail, saved ground to the stretch, was taken off the fence and never threatened. BATTI MAN (ARG) outside rival early, chased from off the rail then three wide and weakened.
