SO BRILLIANT broke in a bit, had speed between horses then dueled just off the rail, battled alongside a rival into and on the turn and in the stretch, inched away under urging a sixteenth out and held gamely. BROTHER FRANCIS broke slowly, chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. HODGE angled in and forced then stalked the pace inside on the backstretch, bid again along the rail into the turn, fought back in the stretch and just held third. SHEER TALENT pulled his way up along the inside to stalk the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, angled back inward in the drive and was edged for the show. MUCHOS BESOS stalked three deep, was forced out early on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. EMPIRE WAY settled off the rail, also was forced out some early on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GALEX had good early speed and dueled outside then alongside the winner, broke down into the turn.
