6 FURLONGS. (1.073) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 *PRIORESS S. (GRADE I)* FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$2,500 to pass the entry box. All starters to receive a \$1,250 rebate. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any filly that competes in both the Prioresse and Test at Saratoga will have their subscription fees waived for the Test. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000; or \$45,000 in 2010, 4 lbs.; \$30,000, or two races, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter, restricted and restricted stake races not considered in allowances.) Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, June 19, 2010 with 15 Nominations. (Clear 92)

FRANNY FREUD away in good order, sat chilly off the early three-way pace tussle up front, continued to bide her time during the early portion of the run around the bend, ranged up when ready three wide, took charge soon after turning for home, was driven to a clear advantage by midstretch, drifted out several paths, then was flashed the stick from the right side by the rider in the late stages to be put back on course. CHAMPAGNE D'ORO bobbed at the break, fought for the lead between rivals, backed off a bit after leaving the half mile, continued the chase from the two path, was boxed in and forced to be kept on hold, altered course near the three-sixteenths pole to free herself from this predicament, then closed with good courage down the strip to garner place honors. BONNIE BLUE FLAG ducked in at the start, vied from the rail with a pair of rivals soon afterwards, remained a forward factor throughout and finished willingly en route for the show. STORMANDAPRAYER fought a twosome three wide for early command, opened up a clear lead entering the turn, continued on the front, came under assault approaching the head of the lane and succumbed. FUNNY FEELING taken hold early, raced four wide, was set down turning for home and gave way.
