SHADOWBDANCING stalked the early pace from the outside, crept close up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the second turn, responded when asked to duel with RACING BRAN through the drive and inched clear late while dropping to the rail the final yards. RACING BRAN away in good order to duel for the early lead with KING DAN, remained engaged with that one up the backstretch, remained in a battle entering the drive, was engaged by the winner upper stretch but could not keep pace. GOLDEN YANK unhurried early while outside rivals, crept closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded and had a mild late gain. MYTHICAL POWER was never far back, inched closer entering the second turn but had nothing left for the drive. KING DAN dueled from the outside early, remained forward entering the second turn but tired in the drive. RED LEAD pressed the early pace inside but had no late response. GOING BALLISTIC was off a step slow and no factor. BRASS HAT was no threat. SLEW'S TIZZY chased the early pace inside then
