1 1/2 MILES. (1.463) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 (Includes \$50,000 BC - Breeders' Cup) PRAIRIE MEADOWS CORNHUSKER H. (GRADE II) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box and \$3,000 additional to start. \$250,000 guaranteed and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup Nominees only. The Host Association's monies divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH A FEE OF \$6,000 TO ENTER AND START. Weights: Friday, June 19. Breeders' Cup Fund Monies also correspondingly divided provided a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to fund. Starters to be named through the entry-box with the usual time of closing. This race will not be divided and if the entry number exceeds (14), preference will be given to Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal weight assignment. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second parts of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The winning owner will receive a trophy from Breeders' Cup Limited. (Clear 88)

SHADOWDANCING stalked the early pace from the outside, crept close up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the second turn, responded when asked to duel with RACING BRAN through the drive and inched clear late while dropping to the rail the final yards. RACING BRAN away in good order to duel for the early lead with KING DAN, remained engaged with that one up the backstretch, remained in a battle entering the drive, was engaged by the winner upper stretch but could not keep pace. GOLDEN YANK unhurried early while outside rivals, crept closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, responded and had a mild late gain. MYTHICAL POWER was never far back, inched closer entering the second turn but had nothing left for the drive. KING DAN dueled from the outside early, remained forward entering the second turn but tired in the drive. RED LEAD pressed the early pace inside but had no late response. GOING BALLISTIC was off a step slow and no factor. BRASS HAT was no threat. SLEWS TIZZY chased the early pace inside then faded steadily after three quarters.
