Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Medaglia d'Oro - Instant Thought by Kris S.. Trainer Proctor F. Thomas. Bred by Sean Fitzhenry(ON).

MARKETING MIX, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter in hand racing to the backstretch, moved to wrest command when given her cue nearing upper stretch, then moved well clear under firm left handed prompting. SEA LEVEL DRIVE tracked off the second flight under rating while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch, briefly awaited an opening racing three deep between foes nearing upper stretch, shifted out nearing the furlong marker and continued with a steady effort to edge a rival for second. MAID OF HEAVEN was settled outside foes in the opening half, made a steady advance to contention racing five wide through the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was just outkicked for second. SUMMER SAVORY tracked the leaders three deep off the second flight under rating in the opening half, made steady progress four deep on the far turn to gain striking distance entering upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure and was outkicked for a share. BARBIES M, bumped at the start, was settled along the inside racing to the backstretch, continued under reserve waiting for an opening racing through the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and came through close quarters in late stages to improve her placing. ARTEMUS KITTEN was settled in last racing to the far turn, angled outside foes to race eight wide into upper stretch and made some belated progress. ANGELICA ZAPATA broke inwards, was collected to track the leaders between foes off the second flight racing to the second bend, angled out four wide nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. SANTINA DOND stalked the leaders within striking distance along the inside under light rating racing to the far turn but steadily faded entering upper stretch. TRAC N JAM broke inwards bumping SEANS SILVERDANCER, was righted to track off the second flight between foes under some reserve, was taken in hand when avoiding some close quarters nearing the second bend, continued three deep between foes to upper stretch but offered no rally. TRIUNE was urged to a contending position in the second flight racing well off the inside to the backstretch, made some progress to lodge a brief, three wide bid entering the far turn but emptied out leaving the furlong marker. SEANS SILVERDANCER, bumped at the start, was guided to the rail gaining position midpack, tracked the leaders along the inside to the second bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. HAPPY CHOICE, reserved between foes in the opening stages, angled out seven wide entering upper stretch, made some contact with DON'T TELL SOPHIE nearing midstretch and offered no rally. DON'T TELL SOPHIE broke outwards bumping BARBIES M, was settled between foes racing to the backstretch, angled out five wide nearing upper stretch, was bumped nearing the furlong marker and had no further response. LOVE DARE, urged to the lead outside a rival racing to the first turn, set the pace on a clear margin into the far turn but gave way abruptly once headed by the winner.
