(GRADE I) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD.* By invitation with no nomination or starting fee, with \$500,000 guaranteed of which \$300,000 to the owner of the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$50,000 to third, \$25,000 to fourth, \$15,000 to fifth and \$10,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 121 lbs. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at a Nine Furlongs on the main track. (Cloudy 41)

HOT CHA CHA was well placed along the inside, got through entering the stretch, shook clear and widened through the drive. SHARED ACCOUNT was away alertly and set the pace off of the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner but kept on well to hold the place. GOZZIP GIRL tracked the pace three deep, drew even nearing the quarter pole but went evenly through the drive. MISS WORLD was unhurried into stride, angled out leaving the second turn to make a mild rally and improved her position. LADY SHAKESPEARE was allowed to settle, was floated out leaving the second turn, drifted out further into the stretch and finished with a belated gain. HAMEILDAEME (GB) settled saving ground and failed to respond. BLIND DATE was forwardly placed three wide through the second turn, but angled in entering the stretch and faltered.
