ASHLEY'S KITTY stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. SHE'S CHEEKY was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. EVITA ARGENTINA was a bit slow into stride and bobbled slightly in the opening strides, settled outside a rival then off the rail, continued outside on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and could not offer

the necessary late rally. SO LONG SONOMA chased off the rail, angled in some on the turn, was between horses into the stretch and did not rally. MOON DE FRENCH had good speed and dueled inside the winner, fought back on the turn and weakened in the stretch. STOLEN
