(GRADE III) FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and \$1,000 additional to start with \$100,000 Guaranteed and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for CUP ELIGIBLES ONLY. The Host Association's monies divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, and 2% to sixth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an award position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Weights: To be announced Sunday, March 1. This race will not be divided. Preference will be given in the following order: Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal racing quality or weight assignment (Respective of sex and weight for age). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning Owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Nominations closed Friday, February 27, 2009 with 27 nominees. LET IT ROCK lacked early speed while reserved, saved ground into the lane, split foes midstretch, finished up willingly to prove best.

SHIM'S PRIDE unhurried, brief wait second turn, swung to the outside for the drive, set down, also finished up well but was unable to match strides with the winner late. CATMANTOO within striking distance, four wide in the second turn, moved out, outkicked in the late going.

SPOTSGONE clear first in the turn, set the pace, continued inside, weakened the final furlong. PROM SHOES last away, trailed early, made a middle move five wide to challenge second turn, faltered. JONESBORO prompted the pace off the inside, challenged, had little left late.

SILVER EDITION forwardly placed, gave way the final furlong.
