HONOR CODE stumbled slightly at the start, recovered to be just off the pace early on through the first turn, pulled his way to attend the pace from just off the inside, came under light coaxing into the far turn and took closer order on the leader, raced between foes nearing the quarter pole, got set down at that station, was in the midst of seizing command when CAIRO PRINCE went to the front narrowly in upper stretch, dug in inside that foe through the final eighth steadily gaining inside fighting on gamely to the wire and just up on the wire. CAIRO PRINCE three to four wide in close aim of the front, got set down swinging outside the leading pair from the three path at the quarter pole, took narrow command nearing the eighth pole, dug in gamely fighting head to head with the aforementioned foe through to the wire but was nailed in the last jump. WICKED STRONG tossed his head at the start getting off a bit awkward, settled just off the pace just off the inside, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide for home, rallied with good energy erratically shying from the stick through the lane a bit green, finished well steadily gaining on the front pair to secure the show. INTENSE HOLIDAY broke out a step at the start and was corrected, settled three wide in mid pack in hand, came under light coaxing four wide at the three-eighths pole before being set down five wide into upper stretch, momentarily had his momentum broken as the erratic WICKED STRONG drifted out in front a sixteenth from home offering up a mild kick for the last major share. MASTER LIGHTNING on the pace inside in hand, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths coming under some pressure by a pair, got displaced in upper stretch and weakened in the lane. MATUSZAK three to four wide towards the rear, raced five wide midway on the turn, spun six wide for home under a drive from the five-sixteenths and offered no serious response. AFLEET ACCOMPLI just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and made no impact. MENTAL ICEBERG brushed the near side stall at the start, settled three wide in range of the front in hand, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, faded in the latter portion of the turn and tired.
