7 FURLONGS. (1.223) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 RESEARCHER S. FOR THREE YEARS OLD. Free nominations close Saturday, September 7, 2013. \$1,500 to enter, with a purse of \$400,000 guaranteed. Supplemental nominations of \$20,000 will be accepted at time of entry, which includes all fees. Horses having won a North American, European or Asian Graded or Group race shall receive a refund of \$1,500 of their entry or supplemental fees upon starting. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 7th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to 6th. Weight, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stake in 2013 allowed 3 lbs., non-winners of \$50,000 since July 1, 2013 allowed 6 lbs. Field will be limited to ten starters with up to four alternates. Preference to North American, European, and Asian graded or group stakes winners in order (Grade 1, then Grade 2, then Grade 3), then to highest earnings in North American, European and Asian graded and group stakes, then to highest lifetime earnings. Entries close Wednesday, September 18, by the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner, trainer and jockey. (Cloudy 68)

TAKE IT LIKE A MAN, in close quarters soon after the break, angled outside on the backstretch, rushed up outside rivals entering the far turn, gained the lead approaching the stretch then edged away in the drive. **MONGOLIAN SATURDAY**, sent early, disputed the pace outside **WHISKEY ROMEO**, opened a clear advantage mid way down the backstretch, saved ground the final turn and gave way grudgingly. **BOND VIGILANTE** lacked speed, circled both turns three deep and rallied slightly. **HEAVEN'S RUNWAY**, in close quarters soon after the start, saved ground, advanced on the far turn then failed to sustain his bid. **WYNN'S NIGHTHAWK** bore out leaving the starting gate, was well back early, swung out turning for home and passed tired foes. **DO IT FOR DON**, steadied when shuffled back leaving the starting gate, raced between rivals leaving the backstretch and failed to rally. **EMILE** was outrun. **OUR DOUBLE PLAY**, three deep the first turn, chased the pace, angled to the inner rail, saved ground the far turn and faltered in midstretch. **RES JUDICATA** saved ground around the first turn, angled out on the backstretch, steadied in tight quarters leaving the backstretch then dropped back. **WHISKEY ROMEO** hugged the rail, disputed the pace and faltered leaving the backstretch.
