BAYEUX, never far back while racing between foes in hand three wide, was asked for more nearing the final quarter, inched after front-running BALLAST (IRE) when straightened for the drive, took over a sixteenth out and drove clear. LORD ADMIRAL, well in hand early

and four wide, worked his way out nine wide when straightened for the drive and closed well for the place. BALLAST (IRE) went up early to press front-running CHIEF EXPORT in hand three wide through soft fractions, swept to the fore on the far turn, was clear for the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. VICTORY DESIGN (IRE), unhurried and four wide during the run down the backstretch, maneuvered seven wide to make a bold run into the final furlong but was empty late. SILVER WHISTLE, taken in hand early and maneuvered near the hedge, continued inside when advancing around the far turn, eased out three wide for the drive and managed a mild gain.

COURTNALL, well placed under light rating near the inside for seven furlongs, eased out four wide for the drive but failed to fire. ART MASTER, a bit sluggish to begin, worked his way in behind foes early, inched up between horses three or four wide around the far turn but flattened out when straightened for the drive, ERRONEOUS I D stalked the pace five wide into the upper stretch and weakened. CHIEF EXPORT moved to the fore at once, angled near the inside, stepped modest early fractions, lost the advantage to BALLAST (IRE) entering the
