GHOST IS CLEAR outrun early, advanced inside entering the turn, responded and finished with a late rush. IVAN FALLUNOVALOT forced the early pace inside but had nothing left. ALSVID chased the early pace outside but had no late response. OKIE RIDE could only pass tired ones. CASPIAN CROWN had a steady fade. CASTLETOWN was never close. WINE POLICE forced the early pace and faded.
