SEVENTH STREET broke alertly, pressed the pace well off the rail on the backstretch, surged to the front at the five-sixteenths pole,

LUNA VEGA trailed for a half, gained along the inside midway on the turn, swung three wide while rallying at the quarter pole and flattened out in upper stretch. SKYLIGHTER raced well off the rail on the backstretch, was outrun to the turn and lacked a late response. BE FAIR rushed up along the inside to gain the early advantage, set the pace out from the rail to the turn and gave way thereafter. EXOTIC INDY failed to mount a serious rally while four wide.
