Bay Filly, (Apr), by Pulpit - Quiet Kim by Real Quiet. Trainer Baffert Bob. Bred by WinStar Farm, LLC(KY). FIFTYSHADESOFHAY bumped lightly into the left side of the starting gate, sat reserved from off the inside racing down the backstretch,

got asked fto pick up the pace coming to the midway point on the turn, ducked in towards the inside for a respite after the runner up had abandoned the inside route soon afterwards, didn't stay put too long, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, was almost at the three-sixteenths marker before getting asked for her best, narrowed the gap, altered course to be outside the front runners with about a

sixteenth to go, kicked into her stride after completing the maneuver, accelerated by them in the shadow of the finish line to prove best. GRACE HALL was lightly coaxed tracking the front runners, kept at a slight distance from off the rail, got cued up and slipped towards the outward approaching the five-sixteenths marker, finished the move being four wide, made up enough ground to latch on to MY WANDY'S GIRL with a furlong remaining, battled on gamely to claim place honors. MY WANDY'S GIRL assumed a forward position, prompted the pace while taking the two path, ranged up to challenge in earnest as the field headed for the top of the lane, worked her way to the front during the ensuing furlong, dug in well after getting engaged in a duel with the runner up shortly afterwards, got reeled in by the winner with a few strides

to spare before the end then got nipped for the place as well. SIX QUEENS put to some light hand urging, established control, cut the pace being rated along from the rail, with MY WANDY'S GIRL keeping watch from the two path, had that one increase the pressure as three-quarters was being completed and got called upon in response, relinquished before reaching the eighth pole and weakened thereafter. TOASTING three wide entering the turn, was in the five path exiting it, had no offering. PARC MONCEAU parked out in the three path off the
