STARLARKS (IRE) a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then a bit off the fence, came out on the second turn and six wide into the stretch, rallied while drifting in some under urging and got up on the wire. STRAWBERRY TART pulled her way between horses and bumped with a rival while in tight into the first turn, stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, gained the lead outside the pacesetter in midstretch, inched away and held well but was caught late. HAMEILDAEME (GB) angled in and chased outside a rival, went three and four wide on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied between horses in the drive. INTERNALLYFLAWLESS settled a bit off the rail then inside, split horses on the second turn, came out five wide into the stretch and finished with some interest. CARLSBAD between horses early, pulled her way along and set a pressured pace inside, kicked clear on the second turn, fought back inside the runner-up in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. ACTING LADY angled in and stalked the pace outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. KAWEAH PRINCESS chased outside then alongside a rival, split horses on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. NAN pulled her way along inside and steadied sharply in tight into the first turn, chased inside, steadied again leaving the second turn, went around a rival into the stretch then lacked the needed rally inside. FASTONGRASS was in a good position stalking the pace inside, steadied while dropping back leaving the second turn and had little left for the stretch. OILGONEWILE bobbed at the start, pulled her way along outside then drifted out into the first turn, prompted the pace outside a rival, steadied while dropping back fast between foes on the second turn and gave way.
