CHARLIE EM (GB) three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and was outfinished for the show. JUDY IN DISGUISE (GB) broke in and bumped a rival, was in a good position chasing the pace outside a foe, came out some in the stretch, split rivals late and was outkicked for a minor award. LILBOURNE ELIZA (IRE) pulled and dueled outside the runner-up then stalked just off the rail, was between horses leaving the turn and through most of the

stretch and lacked the needed late kick. DISKO DASKO (FR) angled in and settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, continued inside in the drive and lacked the needed rally. MISS EMPIRE broke out and bumped a rival, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, was in tight along the fence into the second turn and could not summon the necessary response. KYRIAKI bumped

and squeezed back at the start, settled inside then went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, continued alongside that foe on the second turn and was not a threat.
