Chestnut Colt, (Jan), by Smarty Jones - Apasionata Sonata by Affirmed. Trainer Amoss M. Thomas. Bred by Clover Leaf Farms II, Inc. (FL).

BACKTALK was reserved for a half, worked his way forward three wide on the turn, swung six wide for clear sailing entering the stretch, made a steady run to challenge inside the furlong marker, dug in when threatened in deep stretch and prevailed after a hard drive.

ENUMERATE saved ground in good position just off the pace to the turn, raced behind a wall of horses then checked a bit in traffic in upper stretch, angled out between horses to get clear at the three-sixteenths pole and closed steadily but could not get up. LOUISVILLE LUMINARY was in hand between horses along the backstretch, swung five wide at the quarter pole, surged to the front in midstretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. NACHO FRIEND was reserved early, angled to the inside leaving the backstretch, saved ground while launching his bid on the turn, raced in traffic entering the stretch, moved out in upper stretch, split horses to get clear in midstretch then rallied belatedly. BULLS AND BEARS checked after ducking out and breaking awkwardly, was outrun for a half, swung wide while drifting out at the quarter pole and close late in the middle of the track. BRICKLAYER dropped back early and never reached contention. ACTIVITY REPORT dueled three wide for a half, battled into midstretch and gave way. INTERACTIF pressed the pace between horses for five furlongs and faltered. SOUNDMAN dueled on the rail into upper stretch and gave way.
