Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II race at One Mile or Over since July 16, 2010, allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II race at One Mile or Over OR Two Grade III races at One Mile or Over since January 16, 2010, 5 lbs.. BOURBON BAY stalked the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead outside the runner-up in deep stretch and proved best. CHAMP PEGASUS prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked just off the rail, bid alongside that one again on the second turn to gain the lead, inched away in the stretch, fought back inside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly. SEBASTIAN FLYTE (GB) chased outside a rival then off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. IMPONENTE PURSE (BRZ) stalked between horses then inside, came out into the stretch and was edged for third. UNUSUAL SUSPECT three deep on the hill, angled in and chased a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn and through the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. RIVIERA COCKTAIL squeezed a bit at the start, settled inside then came out into the backstretch, went three deep into the second turn and five wide into the stretch and also was outfinished for a minor share. WHERE'S THE REMOTE pulled a bit early, chased outside a rival then between foes, continued off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PHILATELIST stalked inside then came off the rail leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival into the second turn, angled out into the stretch and lacked a further response. MARLANG sent to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled again on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. EXPANSION angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) allowed to settle off the pace outside, went three deep into the second turn, came out into the stretch and failed to menace.
