ECLAIR DE LUNE (GER) broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, steadied when coming out behind foes on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and split horses at the wire. IT TIZ chased outside a rival, steadied in tight off heels midway on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and was outfinished.
