Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II race at One Mile or Over since July 11, 2010, allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II race at One Mile or Over OR Two Grade III races at One Mile or Over since February 11, 2010, 5 lbs. VISION IN GOLD sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn, fought back a bit off the rail in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. ZARDANA (BRZ) had speed outside the winner then stalked just off the rail, bid alongside that one again on the backstretch and second turn, battled gamely between horses through a long drive and continued willingly to the wire. ST TRINIANS (GB) reserved a bit off the rail then moved up inside on the backstretch and into the second turn, came out for room on that turn, angled three deep into the stretch, bid three wide through the drive and also went on willingly to the end. WASHINGTON BRIDGE stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch, continued just off the inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MONA DE MOMMA stalked outside a rival, fell back a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled in for the second turn and weakened.
